ECO-DEVELOPMENT PLAN

THE FOLLOWING ECO-DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES ARE BEING PLANNED TO BE EXECUTED BY THE UNIT IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH THE DIRECTIVE OF THE POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD, ASSAM.

1. PLANTATION:

A) SITE BOUNDARY PLANTATION

The Company has already undertaken Plantation works around its boundary and the same has been completed.

B) ROAD SIDE PLANTATION (INTERNAL)

The company had contemplated to cover the areas by the internal roads of the factory site with plantation, which has already been completed. The plantation includes the natural habitant plants (thick leafed) as well as ornamental plants, thereby intending to create a green ambience around the factory site.

C) ROAD SIDE PLANTATION (OUTSIDE)

The company has a plan to undertake plantation drive by the side of Chandrapur Road upto 1.50 Kilometers in both direction of the road from the factory site, which shall be undertaken very shortly.

D) OPEN AREA PLANTATION

The company has planned to go for massive plantation in its open area, which has already been undertaken and it shall be completed within March, 2008.

E) FRUIT GARDEN AND ORNAMENTAL PLANTATION.

The company is already maintaining a Fruit Garden in a large area of land. The ornamental plantation has already been completed inside the factory premises.

2. COMPANY'S SOCIO-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME:

A) MEDICAL CAMPS:

The company has the plan to organize Free Medical Camps in its locality covering the villages within 05.00 KM radius at an interval of Six (6) months. The first of its kind was organized on 14-11-2007, at Bonda L.P. School premises where more than 600 local people have been extended with Free Medical Care and Free Medicines were distributed among the patients.

B) PROVIDING RELIEF TO FLOOD AFFECTED AREAS:

The company has the provision to extend the helping hands to the people at the time of Natural Calamity like flood, famine etc.

C) PROVIDING HEALTH CARE SERVICES:

The company has been providing Health Care Services to the people residing in the villages adjacent to the factory through its charitable dispensary called Bonda Charitable Dispensary, where daily 200 patients are being treated by a team of four (4) Doctors of different specialty.

D) CANTEEN WASTE MANAGEMENT :

The Company has already undertaken the plan for managing bio degradable waste by converting into bio-mass through which the waste generated in the canteen is recycled and used in organic farming in side the factory premises.
